Name	Meaning	How to fix
Invalid Syntax	If you forget the colon on an if-statement or Loop or use a symbol that does not belong.	IDLE will highlight what caused the error.
NameError: name is not defined	Happens when you enter a variable name incorrectly or type out a string without adding quotation marks.	The error message will tell you which line caused the error.
TypeError: unsupported operand type(s) for +: 'int' and 'str'	Caused by trying to add an integer to a string.	If you see any error with ' int ' and ' str ' or any other data types then there is a good chance you need to convert one of their data types to match the other.

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
