

Style Cheat Sheet

All style properties need to be placed inside the style attribute: **style=""**

Attributes are placed inside the opening tag of an HTML element.

Multiple style properties can be used as long as they are separated by a semi-colon (;)

Example: <body **style="text-align: center; color: red; padding: 40px;"**></body>

Property	Possible Options	Definition
background-color:	red, blue, green, #282828, #df1298	Changes the background colour of the HTML element.
color:	red, blue, green, #282828, #df1298	Changes the text colour inside the HTML element
border:	2px solid black, 1px dotted #282828	Creates a border around the HTML element.
border-radius:	10px, 30px, etc	It makes the border corners rounded.
float:	left, right	Sets which side the element should be displayed.
text-align:	left, right, center	Set's where text should be aligned.
padding:	10px, 20px, etc	Adds padding to the element
margin:	10px, 20px, etc	Adds a margin to the element.
font-size:	10px, 20px, etc	Changes the font size.
font-weight:	normal, bold	Sets the font to bold.
